At Crofton we are lucky to have a fabulous LRC space, home to a great choice of books so that we can all read something that we find interesting and engaging.






There is a great team of Student Librarians who work at their own desk in the LRC durring break and lunch times.

In September you will be given a login to be able to search for, reserve, renew and review your books






We also have a digital library that you can access at home to access ebooks, audiobooks and magazines. We will give you a demo and your login details in September.


