Who am I ?

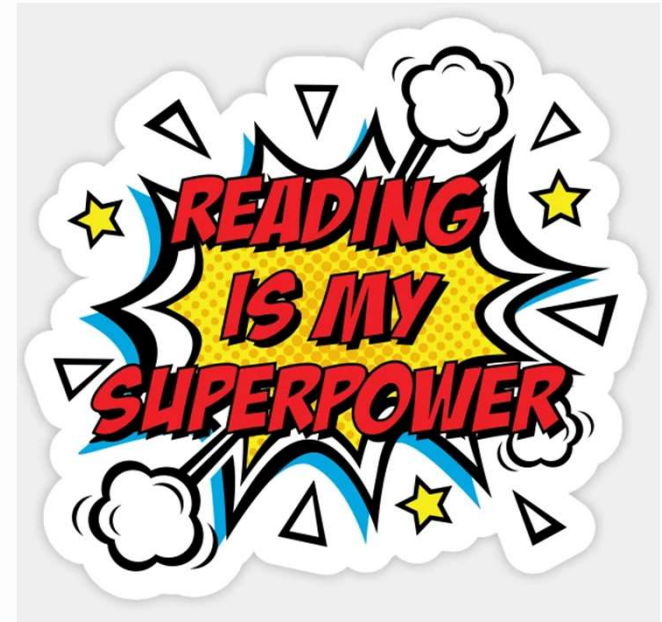


My name is Mrs Bryant

What is Summer Book Club?

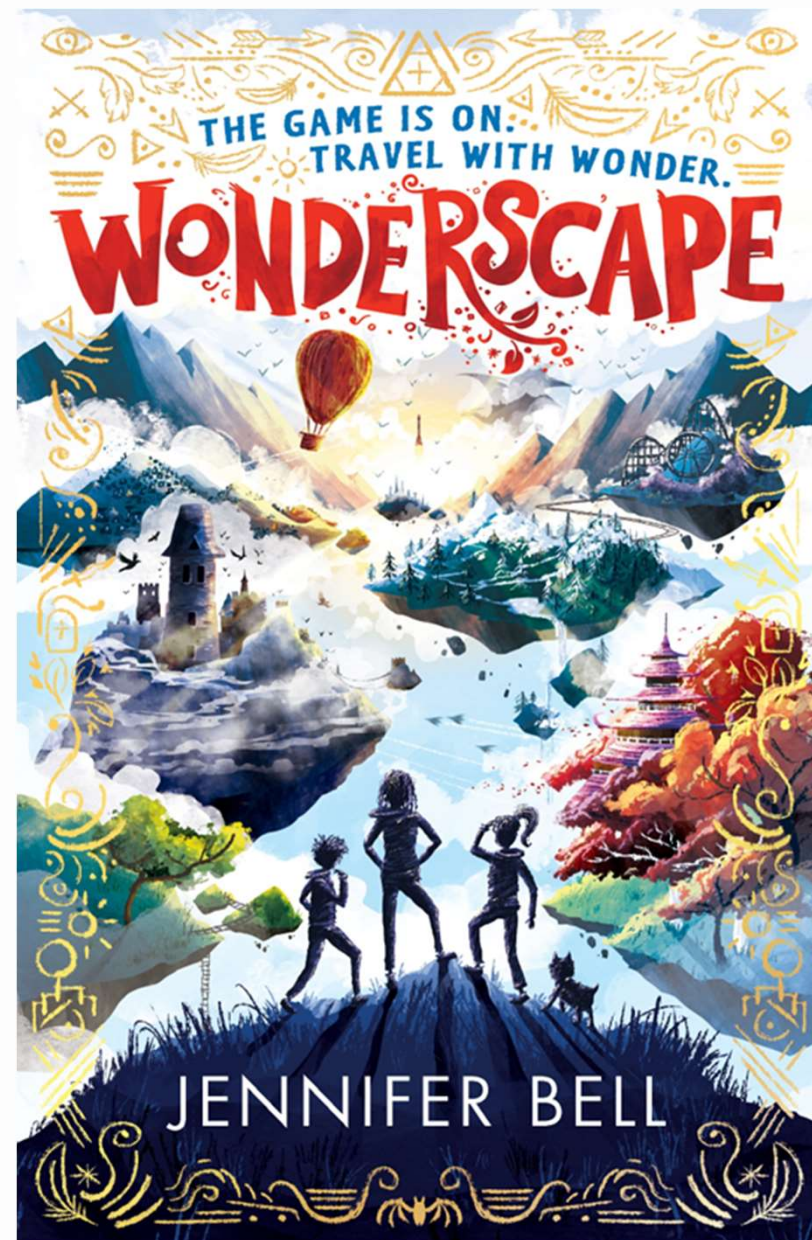
- Lots of schools around the country are doing this too

- You will be invited to a lunchtime Summer Book Club session to celebrate your participation and discuss the book with other students

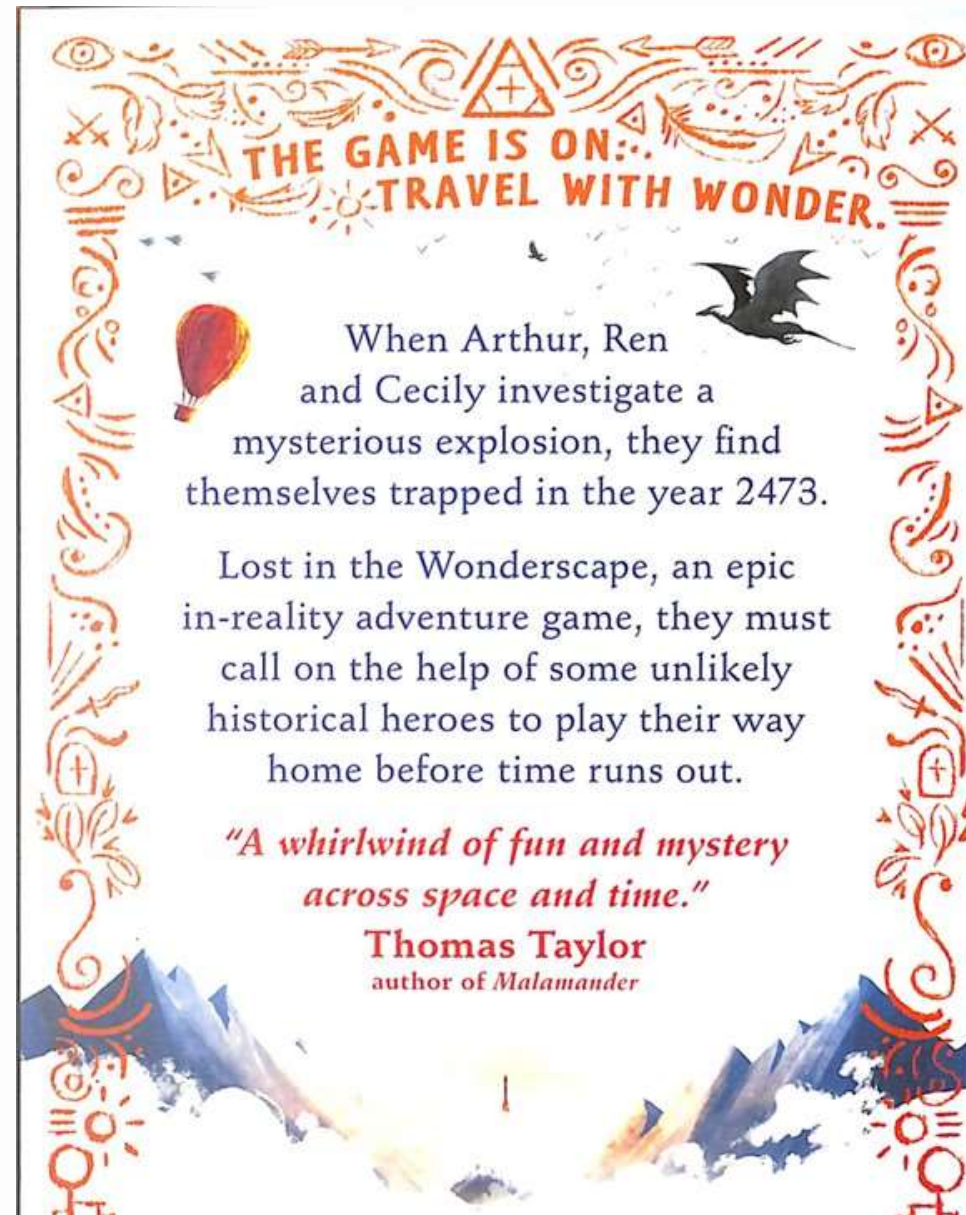
Wonderscape – the cover

- You will be told where to post your completed activity pack when you start in September, and receive an invitation to a Summer Book Club Meetup

How to purchase the book

- The book can be bought in a bookshop or online.
- You can order from Crofton for £4 to collect it on your transition days
- A less expensive option is to buy the e-book - available from Amazon for 99p
